



Olympic Peninsula Fly Clubs Project Healing Waters Programs 2008-2010

1. We have built and donated 250 fly tying tool sets. Each with a retail value of \$115.
2. We created a fly plate with 18 custom designed one of a kind flies representing military campaigns. This was donated to PHW and is now traveling all over the country. It will eventually be sold with the proceeds, (estimated at \$10,000) going towards the welfare of our wounded warriors. The plate was recently featured in Fly Tyeer magazine, the number one national tying magazine.
3. We take the warriors fishing. We have an annual outing for the recovering service personnel each May. We provide fishing instruction, fly-tying instruction, a barbeque, and a day of fishing on the Olympic Peninsula. This year's trip will be on May 27th.
4. We collected over 1000 fly fishing magazines and gave them to Ft. Lewis for distribution to Vet hospitals all over the country. (No more having to read Family Circle while waiting for rehab treatment).
5. This winter, we have collected over 200 cubic feet of fly tying materials and we have packaged them for shipment to all the Vet hospitals that have PHW programs.
6. Currently we are building a 15' wooden fishing boat to be donated to PHW. Completion spring 2010.
7. We sell PHW posters, t-shirts, and medallions at farmers markets and festivals with proceeds going to PHW.
